Team Redington Well Represented at FFR Casting Competition; Wagner Wins!

DENVER, CO – Clearly one of the most exciting events of Fly Fishing Retailer was the Orvis/Saltwater Fly Fishing Magazine Casting Competition final, held on Saturday morning, August 26 at the Denver Convention Center. Hundreds of people were in attendance to watch the finals, a showdown between the top 5 male and female casters, and to witness the fun, camaraderie, and skills of these fine professionals.

Team Redington was well represented in the competition. The top male competitor was Team Red's own Jeff Wagner, of Ft. Collins, CO, who garnered the most points for accuracy. Wagner earned \$3750, which was donated to the Nebraska Parks and Game Commission for their Trout Stream Restoration project on Nine Mile Creek located in the Nebraska Panhandle. Commenting on why he chose to donate to NPGC, Wagner states, "Nine Mile is loaded with browns and is a very nice fishing stream. This donation will help with trout habitat improvement and will help the longevity of the stream."

In the women's competition, Team Red's Cathy Beck made a strong showing and placed third in the competition, while Wagner's wife, Kathleen, came up just short of the finals, placing sixth, respectively.
